

CONCERNING REOPENING FOR SERVICES – 07-12-20

On a cellphone, you may need to resize by adjusting with your fingers. Scroll all the way to the bottom to read it all.

Beginning Sunday July 12th LPBC will have one combined on campus service at 11:00 am until further notice. No Sunday School, no nursery.

Doors will be opened at 10:40 am. If you arrive in your car early, please remain in your car until 10:40.

Please read the instruction sign as you enter the building. Practice social distancing while reading the sign and while in line entering the building.

Doors will be propped open for entering and leaving the building. No greeters. Hand sanitizer from touchless dispensers will be available.

As you are entering, there will be a temperature check, at least Sunday July 12th, and possibly other Sundays also.

Social distancing is to be practiced, no handshaking or hugging, or other close contact. No plate passed - offering boxes available.

If you will need water to drink during the service, please bring water bottles. The fountains may or may not be operable.

Chairs will be dispersed; only those who came together can sit together. All others must allow social distancing to the next persons on row.

Please sit at the ends of the rows so seats are available at the other end of the row. If you sit in the middle of the row, the whole row is taken.

If anyone in your family or group has been sick or been around anyone who is sick or has or has had fever, or other symptoms, do not attend.

It is highly recommended that over 65 do not attend. The service will be available to watch at www.linkstolisten.com – Videos Available.

Concerning facemasks, please wear one, especially during arrival & departure. It appears the state is not requiring during worship.

Please wear a mask for the love of the brethren & to protect the vulnerable unless you are exempt for medical or other approved reasons.

Some face masks will be available. Once a mask has been worn, please take it home with you. The intent of masks is to protect others.

While we will have a limited number of masks available (not guaranteed to protect from the coronavirus), please wear your own if available.

The state does highly recommend the wearing of masks, and it is required in public buildings, intended to protect.

The church cannot guarantee anyone that there will be no exposure to Coronavirus or any illness; no one will be judged for not attending.

Those who attend are not to judge those who do not, and those who do not are not to judge those who do. Each one pray for wisdom.
